PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

The way we see marriage is not the way the world sees marriage. The world sees marriage as a romantic gesture, a mere expression of two people's relationship "gone public." When you go to a secular wedding, it is little more than a public contract dressed in poetic words. But Sacramental Marriage is more than that.

Marriage, for us, is the foundation of family. A man and a woman joined together in a lifelong covenant of Christlike love. Not a covenant of feeling good about a relationship, but a covenant of mutual sacrifice. Giving oneself to the other and bringing forth life into the world by that self-giving. Marriage isn't about the couple. Marriage is about the children, bringing them up in a family and giving them a set of full-time parents, mom and dad. God gave us marriage to create a firm foundation for building up the family.
