



## PASTOR'S CORNER

*My Dear Family,*

*Like Lazarus, our health depends on the presence of Christ. When he is present, we are well, but when he is absent and distant, we begin to fade as we starve for the spiritual nourishment that only Christ can provide. Christ always wants to be near us, but when we commit sin, when we fail to live out the commandments, and when we neglect our spiritual life, we push Christ away, creating the distance we often feel in our private moments. As we prepare for Holy Week, take a moment to soberly examine yourself and your relationship with Christ. Is he near you? Are you near him? Do you live every day with him in mind? Do you follow what he has laid out for you or do you wander your own path?*

*However you have distanced yourself from Christ, get rid of it. Close the gap and reconcile with Christ. Do not leave him behind but take him with you everywhere you go.*
