PASTOR’S CORNER

My Dear Family,

The Eucharist is our great gift from God; our manna is the desert of a sinful world. It is also the most sacred thing on this earth, and we have a duty as faithful Catholics to protect the sanctity of this most precious gift. For this reason, we must always treat the Eucharist with respect and awe, even if it seems so normal and common. Practically speaking, what does this look like? First, when we receive communion, we should always do so with a focused heart and mind, remembering that this is God before us. Second we must prepare ourselves to receive the Eucharist worthily, meaning to approach the Eucharist repentant of our sins, in hearts in the case of Venial Sin, and through the sacrament of Confession in the case of mortal sin. Communion is not just a symbolic act. It is a participation in the very essence of heaven. To prepare for communion is to prepare for heaven.
