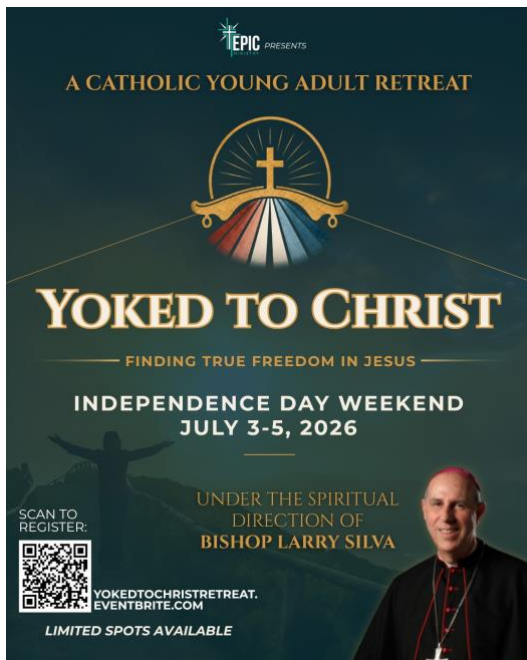


EPIC MINISTRY PRESENTS A CATHOLIC YOUNG ADULT RETREAT
