



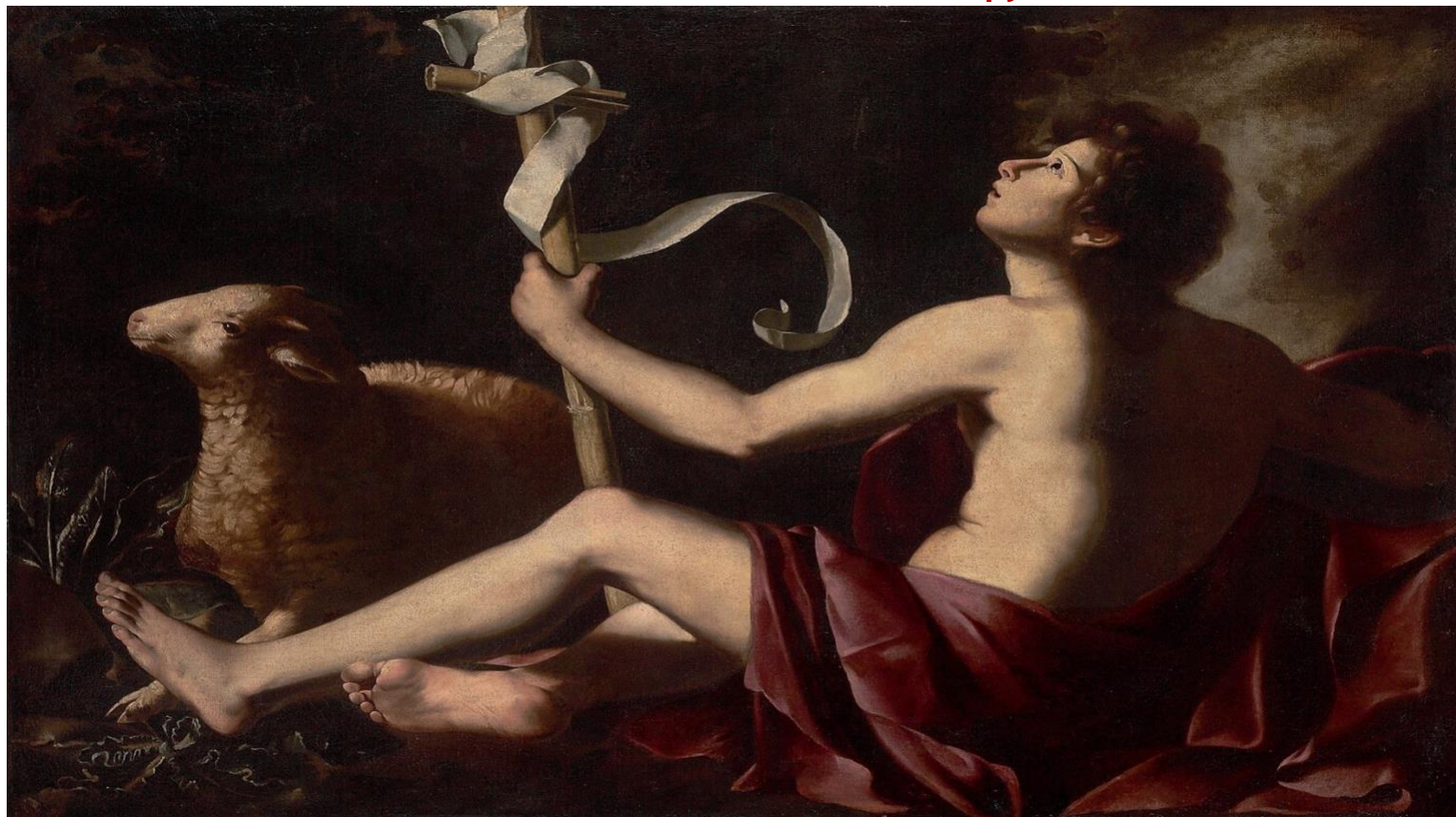

My Dear Family,

Our Lord asks the servants to pour water into the jugs, and then it is he himself who transforms the water into wine.
