PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

“If God is all good and all powerful, why does he allow evil people to do bad things?”

This question, often called The Problem of Evil, is often asked when debating the existence of God. Even if God exists, the argument goes, he could not be all good and all powerful because if he was, he would not allow evil people to act. In the Gospel, Christ helps to answer that question. Even those who choose to do evil are children of God, loved by him no matter what. In his mercy, the Lord gives them a literal lifetime of chances to repent, but if such a man should remain in evil until the end, it will be for God to dispense his justice at the appointed time. When we see unrepentant evil, we must remember that the day of the harvest will come, and God will take the weeds from the wheat and see to their destruction. Therefore, repent of any evil, that you may be counted among the wheat.
