### PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

As we commemorate the souls of all the faithful departed on this All Souls Day, we remind ourselves of that eternal truth of the Gospel: Life is changed, not ended. When a person dies, it is neither the end of their life nor the end of our relationship with them. Sure, we no longer enjoy meals or lengthy conversations with them, and we can feel the distance between us, but their life is still on going, and not only "in our memories."

Just as life is changed but not ended, so to our relationships with the departed may change, but do not end. From here on earth, we still give them support through our prayers, remembering them not as they were on earth, but as they are, standing before the judgment seat of God. As such our relationship with them is rooted in our prayers for them; praying for God's mercy on their behalf and that He may let them into paradise. Remember the dead in your prayers, so that when our time comes, they may greet us at the gates of heaven.
