



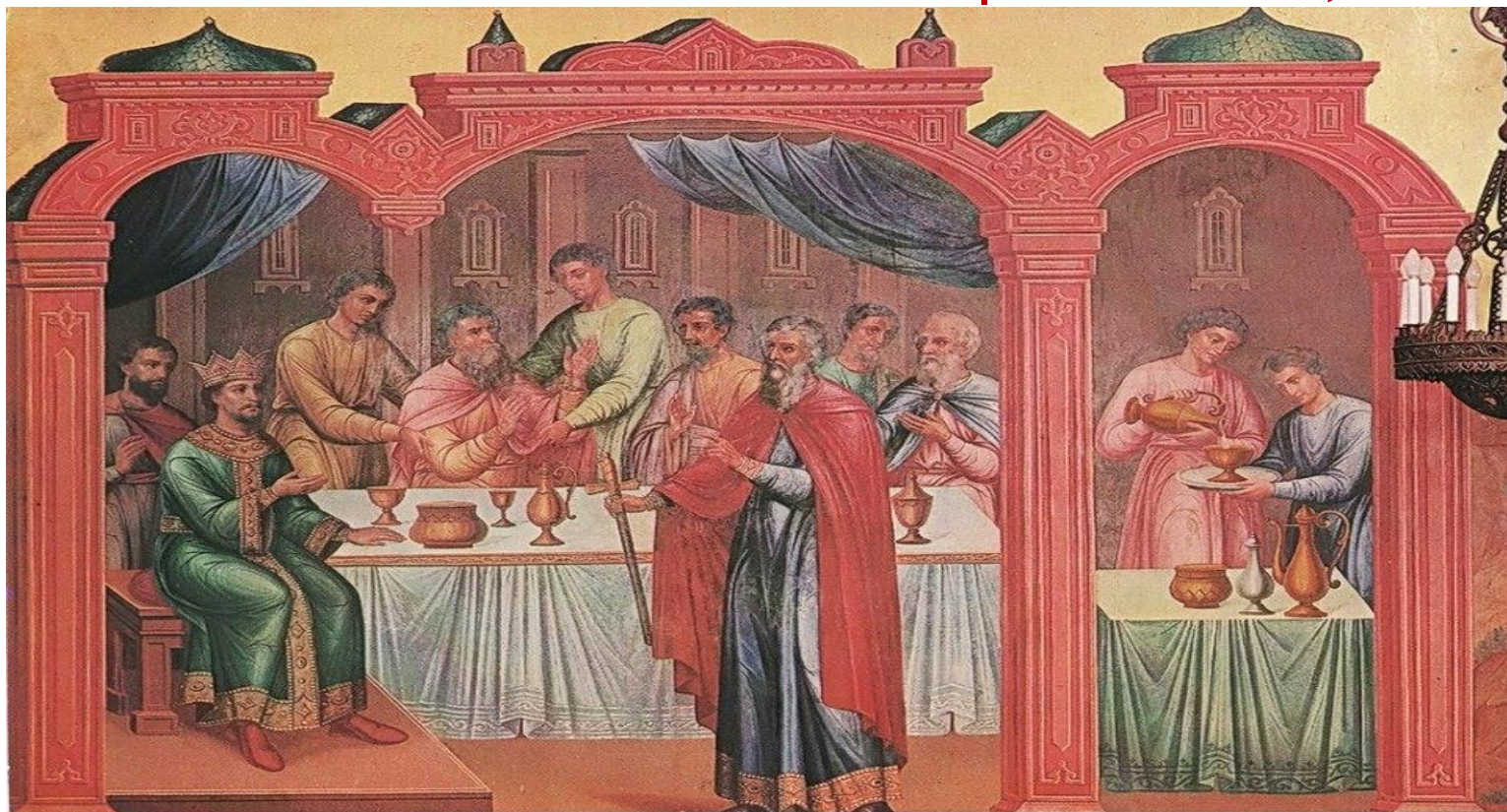

My Dear Family,
