PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

Can we become blind because of sin? Actually, yes, we can. Not physical blindness, but spiritual blindness. Sin, by its very nature, puts up barriers between us and God, and the more we fall into sin, the less aware we become of God's presence in our life. Being spiritually blind essentially means that we can no longer discern God's will for us, and we blindly follow life wherever it leads us, without God to give us direction or focus. Spiritual blindness can have eternal effects on us, as it leads us away from God and into oblivion. The only way to stay out of spiritual blindness is to keep your eyes fixed on Christ and away from sin.
