PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

We cannot serve both God and ourselves. Christ's message is clear that a dishonest man, like the one in the parable, cannot deal dishonestly and get an honest reward, only a dishonest reward. Yet we often find that many try to serve two masters, attempting to follow a Christian lifestyle while at the same time engaging in self-indulgence. What ends up happening as a result is that we become uninterested in pleasing God and focus on ourselves and our own wants, serving ourselves and neglecting God. Our Lord warns us that we are not capable of choosing two masters, we will always choose one or neglect the other. So don't serve two masters, make the choice. Choose God above sin, God above self, God above the world. Serve no one else, only God.
