YARD SALE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

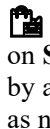
SEPTEMBER 14 – 20, 2026

PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

Seven is the number which represents life on earth. It references the number of days in a week as planned by God from the creation of the world. It is also the number of decades of the average man's lifespan, as spoken in the psalms: "Seventy years of life we are given, or eighty for those who are strong," and elsewhere in the psalms. "Seven times a day I praise you." Even within the Church, the seven sacraments are graces from God given to us throughout our earthly life.

In this context, our Lord tells Peter that he must forgive his brother seventy-seven times, he is saying that he must forgive his brother, "for a lifetime of lifetimes." Many of us struggle to forgive even once. But our Lord tells us that we need to have enough forgiveness in our hearts to forgive lifetimes of wrongdoings. Why? Because that is how much forgiveness God has for us. As God has treated us, so we must treat one another. Forgiveness is God's might.
