





A tragedy occurred this past Wednesday, in which a lone gunman attacked Annunciation Catholic School in Minneapolis during the celebration of Mass, killing two children and wounding seventeen others. This horrific event brings with it not only sorrow, but fear, concerns of safety, and even anger. Yes, even anger would be justified, for not only were two souls taken from us, young and innocent, but they were taken from us while worshiping God in His Holy Temple, a place of hope and love.

Like the early Church, persecuted by her enemies, we are called to imitate the saints who bore witness to tragedy such as this. Like them, we must turn to God in prayer and mourning, but with the hope and promise for the resurrection and life eternal. Let us pray for the victims, their families, and even the gunman himself, for the Lord tells us, "Pray for those who persecute you."
