

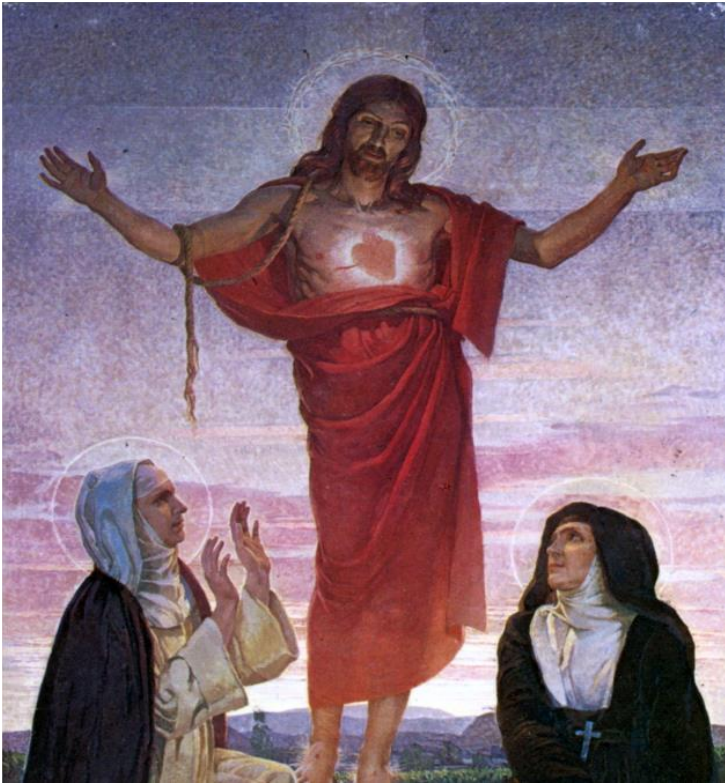

## PASTOR’S CORNER

*My Dear Family,*
