PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

Peter is the Rock on which the Church is built, or, more accurately, Peter's faith in Christ makes him capable of being the rock of faith on which the Church is built. When Jesus makes Peter the first Pope, leader and head of the Church under Christ Himself, it is because Peter recognized both Christ's divine sonship and His authority. Peter is given the keys to the kingdom of heaven not because he is the wisest or because of his leadership skills, but because he puts his absolute trust in Christ and Peter's new authority depends entirely on his deference to Christ.

If we are to be loyal sons and daughters of the Church, we too must have total submission to Christ. Like Peter, we must recognize Christ as the Anointed One and the Son of God, not as empty titles, but with a full understanding of what that means. Peter's profession of faith was more than mere pleasantries. It was a very real recognition of Christ as the source of all authority and truth. Our profession of faith must carry the same weight.
