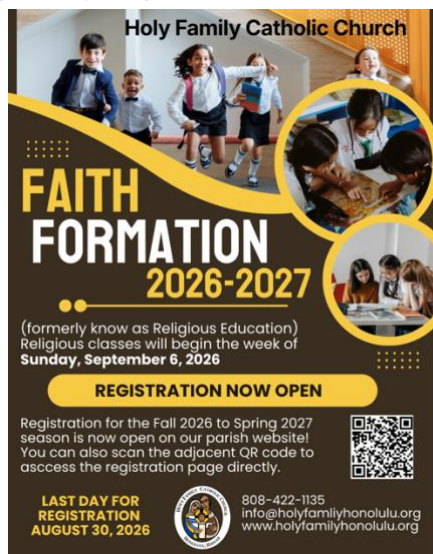

PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Family,

Ego is one of the biggest weaknesses of the human heart. In today's Gospel, which follows up on last week's Gospel, in which Peter is appointed the first pope, we see the same Peter rebuke our Lord, and it does not go well for him. Peter, in his newfound position, has a moment of weakness in which he thinks he could correct God Himself. Why? Well, because he is the leader of the apostles, of course, surely, he has such a privilege.

This is a basic case of power going to someone's head. And our Lord responds strongly, humbling Peter for thinking as human beings do, even going so far as to liken him to Satan! Remember that Peter was appointed keeper of the keys because he recognized the authority of Christ. But when Peter replaces Christ's authority with his own, he is acting like Satan more than a rock of faith. This is a warning to all of us. No matter who we are or what life we have lived, Christ is still in charge. Who are we to contradict Christ?
